- MSCA Doctoral Networks 2024 receives 1417 proposals. The fourth call of the Marie Skłodowska-Curie Actions-funded Doctoral Networks scheme closed on 27 November 2024. The European Research Executive Agency received 1417 proposals. By comparison, 1,066 proposals were submitted in 2023 and 136 were eventually selected for funding. This year's submitted proposals are distributed as follows. Standard Doctoral Networks: 1249 proposals Industrial Doctorates: 80 proposals Joint Doctorates: 88 proposals.
- New guide on trusted repositories: Promoting open science and meeting grant requirements ERC A new study provides a list of trusted repositories across different fields of research, with an assessment of their readiness to facilitate compliance with the Horizon Europe requirements.

Topic: Health.


Organized by: Michael J. Fox Foundation.

Budget: \$ 250,000 - \$ 2 M.

Duration:

- Grants for preclinical programs: 1 2 years.
- Grants for clinical programs: 2 3 years.



Future Leaders Award Programme Topic: Mobility. Organized by: European Foundation for the Study of Diabetes (EFSD) & Novo Nordisk. Destination: Intends to identify outstanding clinical and basic scientists in European diabetes research at a critical stage in their career to support them in their transition to a tenured academic appointment in diabetes research in Europe and foster their development into the leaders of tomorrow. **Budget**: Up to DKK 5 M (approx. € 670,000). **Duration:** 5-year duration subject to satisfactory progress. Deadline: 18th March 2024. More information
