- [MSCA Staff Exchanges 2023 call receives 233 proposals](#). The European Research Executive Agency received 233 proposals. Applicants requested a total budget close to €252.89 million. Through this call, the European Union is expected to fund between 70 and 90 projects with an indicative budget of around €78.5 million. Proposals submitted include the participation of 1,844 different organisations in 121 countries, out of which 39% are non-academic organisations.
- [ERC-Starting Grant 2024](#). For those applicants who, having passed to this second phase with a Spanish Host Institution, wish to train themselves on how to face the ERC interview, the FECYT European Office will organise mock interviews remotely, in order to reproduce as far as possible the same conditions as the real interview.
