Seeking/Offering: Our lab specializes in rapid and highly sensitive detection of biomarkers, including antibodies, proteins, and specific nucleic acid sequences (e.g., RNA or DNA sequences). We have developed a magnetic modulation biosensing technology that sophistically combines fluorescent and magnetic tagging of target molecules. By concentrating the magnetic beads to the laser beam and manipulating them from side to side, we increase the concentration of the fluorescently labeled target molecules and separate them from the constant background noise. We have demonstrated the analytical and clinical performance of the technology for rapid and highly sensitive serological assays (West Nile, Dengue, Zika, SARS-CoV-2), molecular assays (SARS-CoV-2), and other pathogens.

We have extensive experience in in vitro diagnostic technologies and detection of biomarkers in various fields and specifically for point of care applications. We currently have collaborations with the Israeli Central Virology Laboratory and several hospitals in Israel.
