• European Call for Proposals for Funding Projects in The Field of Health Systems

Transformation – THCs: Horizon Europe's new THCS (Transforming Health Care

Systems) partnership, which aims to ensure the transition towards more sustainable,
resilient, innovative, high quality and people-centred health and care systems, is
launching its first transnational call entitled "Healthcare of the Future". Projects must
be carried out by transnational consortia consisting of a minimum of three entities
from three different countries among the participants. This call is co-funded by the

European Commission and different national or regional funding agencies. In the case of Spain, the Instituto de Salud Carlos III participate as funding bodies. Each of these entities establishes its own funding requirements, which must be known before submitting the proposal.


