- MSCA Doctoral Networks 2023 receives 1,066 proposals. This year's MSCA Doctoral Networks call has attracted considerable interest from the research community, with 1,066 proposals submitted.
- Consolidator Grants: ERC unleashes €627m in grants to fuel excellent research across Europe. Out of 2,130 candidates, the

European Research Council (ERC) has selected 308 researchers for this year's Consolidator Grants. The funding will support excellent scientists and scholars at the career stage where they may still be consolidating their own independent research teams to pursue their most promising scientific ideas. Worth in total €627 million, the grants are part of the EU's Horizon Europe programme.


