The Commission and the Arab Republic of Egypt have successfully concluded negotiations on Egypt's association to Horizon Europe, the EU's flagship research and innovation funding programme. The Agreement is expected to be signed by November 2025, with its entry into force subject to final validations by both parties.

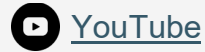
