- **From war damage to heart repair: ERC grantees supported to turn their science into practice** The European Research Council (ERC) has published the outcomes of the last 2025 round of its Proof of Concept Grants. In this round, 136 grantees will each receive €150 000, supporting them in exploring how their scientific results can move towards practical application or early commercial use. With these awards, the total number of Proof of Concept Grants under the ERC 2025 Work Programme reached 300, representing an overall budget of €45 million. The scheme is

funded under Horizon Europe, the EU's framework programme for research and innovation.

Through this collaboration, we aim to develop and apply advanced analytical frameworks to uncover early brain signatures of neurodegenerative disease. Generate or manage EEG, fMRI, and/or MEG datasets, have expertise in clinical neuroscience, neuroimaging biomarkers. Annual Open grant

Destination: Funds research projects that develop alternative methods to advance science and replace or reduce animal use. The mission of the ARDF is to fund and promote the development, validation, and adoption of non-animal methods in the fields of biomedical research, product testing, and education.

Budget: The maximum award amount is 50.000\$ (including indirect costs).

Duration: 1 year. The preferred project period is September 1, 2026 to August 31, 2027. However, projects may start as late as November 1, 2026.

Research Grants

Topic: Immunodeficiency

Destination:

- Translational Research Program

Supports innovative and novel investigations in Primary Immunodeficiency, focusing on translational research leading to meaningful clinical application.

- Specific Defect Research Program

Supports research that studies the mechanisms and presentation of specific defects of the immune system to gain a better understanding of the defects and their impact on overall health outcomes. The JMF encourages novel investigations to expand upon the current list of Specific Defect grant projects (detailed on Specific Defect Research Program tab, on the website)

- C.H.I.L.D.R.E.N! ®

Supports research focused on children living with PI throughout the world, while addressing healthcare disparities, especially in developing countries, through education, testing, diagnosis, and treatment. The focus is to investigate immunological disorders, infectious disease, initiatives to decrease infant mortality and ultimately improve the quality of life of children affected by PI globally.

Budget and duration:

- Translational Research Program.

Duration and funding: up to 250.000\$ over a two-year project period. Funds cannot be used for institutional overhead.

- Specific Defect Research Program.

Duration and funding: up to 50.000\$ over a two-year project period.

Duration and funding: up to 25.000\$ over a two-year project period.

EU Partnership for Pandemic Preparedness (BE READY)

Topic: Health

Organized by: European Commission

Destination: Funds transnational and interdisciplinary research to improve preparedness and response to emerging and re-emerging pathogens with pandemic potential, by advancing understanding of infection mechanisms and host responses.

Budget: ISCIII contribution: 1M€

Maximum funding per proposal

If a Spanish Partner requesting funding to the ISCIII is NOT the Coordinator of the transnational project:

- 220.000€ (overheads included), if there is only one Spanish Partner requesting funding to the ISCIII in the proposal.
- 275.000€ (overheads included), if there are two Spanish Partners requesting funding to the ISCIII in the proposal.

If a Spanish Partner requesting funding to the ISCIII is the Coordinator of the transnational project:

- 300.000€ (overheads included), if there is only one Spanish Partner in the proposal, acting as a coordinator.
- 400.000€ (overheads included), if there is one Spanish Partner in addition to the Spanish Coordinator in the proposal, both requesting funding to the ISCIII.

Overheads according to AES 2026: 25%

Duration: From 24 to 36 months.
