Tau Pipeline Enabling Program V (T-PEP)

In short, T-PEP bridges the gap between innovative but resource-constrained researchers and the larger pharmaceutical companies that are looking for drug candidates to be taken into human trials.

CHALLENGE PROGRAMME 2027 – Advancing Next Generation AMR Diagnostics for Lower Respiratory Tract Infections

Topic: Antimicrobial Resitance & Respiratory Health

Organized by: Novo Nordisk Foundation

Destination:

Support early-stage proof-of-concept research that will enable the development of rapid, minimally invasive and affordable testing for lower respiratory tract infections at the point-of-care in global settings.

Research may include:

- **Technological advancements targeted at improving respiratory sample collection or processing** to enable rapid pathogen separation and/or concentration.

- **Establishing the scientific and clinical validity of minimally invasive techniques and/or identifying relevant biomarkers in proxy samples for rapid diagnosis**, to identify new analytes indicative of infection and LRTI causative agents.
- **Discovery of host and/or pathogen analytes or biometrics** that facilitate differentiation between commensal and disease-causing pathogens.
- **Advancing predictive capabilities of antimicrobial susceptibility gene testing** by establishing and optimising accurate genotype-phenotype correlations.

Budget: The maximum award amount is 10M €

Duration: 6 years maximum

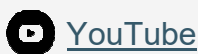
